Using EndNote Web Toolbar with Firefox

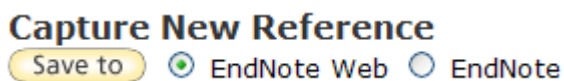
EndNote Web is a web-based citation manager that allows for gathering, storage and management of citations in a web-based environment. EndNote Web accounts can be accessed from any computer with internet access. Citations can be directly transferred from selected databases (Web of Science, PubMed, Library catalog), imported from saved (exported) records, or entered individually.

Install the EndNote Web Toolbar to Firefox:

1. Login to EndNote Web using your email address and password
2. Go to the **Options** tab
3. Select **Download Installers**
4. On the right side under Firefox Extension, click on **Download Windows/Macintosh**
5. Install EndNote Web Toolbar
6. Restart Firefox for the toolbar to appear

Using the EndNote Web Toolbar:

1. Search for sources in any database (CSA, EBSCOHost, etc)
2. From the search results, select the item you want to view details
3. From the toolbar, click on the **Capture** option ( Capture)
4. Login with your email address and password
5. Select where to save the citation to – EndNote Web or EndNote
6. Select the **Save to** button



If Save to EndNote Web...

- Citation will be added to the Unfiled group
- Close the window

If Save to EndNote....

- The download window will open up
- Select **Save to disk** to save file to computer
- Open file using EndNote
